Nothing to Fear

'The grave cannot praise You, death cannot sing Your praise; those who go down to the pit cannot hope for Your faithfulness. The living, the living - they praise You, as I am doing today; fathers tell their children about Your faithfulness. The Lord will save me, and we will sing with stringed instruments all the days of our lives in the temple of the Lord.

-Isaiah 38:18-20

There are many negative images of death in the Bible. Death ends our praise. After Hezekiah's miraculous healing, he wrote a song, affirming that death is the end of praise and worship. His experience of victory over death brought him back to life: "The living, the living - they praise You, as I am doing today"

The fear of the unknown is the biggest reason why we fear death; we don't know what to expect. To believers, death is a gateway to eternal life. Paul says that when we die, we will be with the Lord. Christ conquered death and because He is alive, we will also have eternal life
